Twenty-five, the number repeatedly referenced in the forthcoming pages, speaks to the transition from a dream to an established, nonprofit educational foundation. REA<sup>3</sup>D proudly celebrates its silver anniversary.

By all accounts, leadership in bringing this concept to fruition was then school board member Colleen Maiers and the late Kathy Bush. In Colleen's words, "as liaison to the Proctor Area Community Center, I saw it as an important, valuable community resource. That perspective inspired me to find a way to ensure that

such opportunities would be as widely available as possible in perpetuity."

A group of community members embraced her vision: Sharon Jugasek, Jake Benson, Ted Peterson, Jay Belcastro, Stan Kaitfors, Scott Moe, and Barb Zakrajsek. With legal assistance from Larry Stauber Jr., REA<sup>3</sup>D was "born" on September 11, 1996.

It would take ten years before the organization would reach the threshold of \$100,000, the amount dictated by the Duluth Superior Area Community Foundation, (the staff, businesses, and supporters original depository of all generated like yourselves. funds) before investment earnings could be expended as grant awards. A \$450 check supporting the "Science Olympiad" was one of the first to be awarded a grant.

Now that \$100,000 endowment is approaching five times that amount, or in keeping with the theme of this newsletter, 25 times \$20,000=\$500,000. And yes, that very first grant given has grown in number to over 25 times 6=just over 150 expanded opportunities.

I invite you to review the next seven pages to get a sense of the community support of our quest, a sampling of fundraising events, diversity of requests supported, in addition to the July 1, 2020-June 30, 2021 contributions by Proctor

As Maiers concluded, "helping to establish REA<sup>3</sup>D was one of my most satisfying experiences. "I embrace her sentiments as president of this foundation.


# REA<sup>3</sup>D's Memorable Community Outreach Events
